Debra Johnson, Chair of the CSCB says, “We know that with the speed in which information travels, and with the abundance of programs, initiatives and resources that have been announced, people can become overwhelmed. Our aim is to organize as much material into one central location that can be accessed by members of our community as well as our partner agencies that are helping people navigate through this difficult time”.

The website, developed in partnership with The St. Clair County Emergency Operations Center (EOC), St. Clair County Health Department, and St. Clair County Community Mental Health (SCCCMH), will be updated continually as new information becomes available.

“Having this critical and necessary life sustaining information available at your fingertips, ensures that our community is able to meet personal and family needs at a time when resources are less available.” says Justin Westmiller, Director of St. Clair County Homeland Security and Emergency Management.
