Rules and Information

Show starts at 8:30 a.m. with a break for lunch Horse Show Entries

Early Bird Fees:

MUST be received Monday prior to SHOW DAY *We now accept e-transfers for early bird only at <u>dwyerhillridingclub@gmail.com</u> (provide password to show secretary at time of entry)

All Riders

All Day Fee - \$70 (*Open payout classes not included) \$10 per class

Open Pay Out Classes

\$20 per class Payout to 3rd based on 6 or less entries Payout to 5th based on 7 or more entries

Regular Fees:

All Riders All day Fee - \$90 \$12 per class

No REFUNDS for scratches

Membership Fees:

Single \$40 – Family \$85

Ponies/minis may enter halter, showmanship and in hand trial classes

Lead Line - Not eligible to ride alone in any other class and must be led by a person 16 years or older and must wear a riding helmet

Walk Trot/Jog Division - Exhibitors cannot enter other classes with a lope/canter

Youth Rider – Exhibitor 18 years and younger as of January 1st , 2024 (note: must wear a helmet)

Adult RIDER – over 18 as of Jan 1st

Novice Rider is considered someone who 1) is new to showing 2) has not received 1st or 2nd place at open shows the last 2 years in performance classes 3) has not earned breed points in performance classes

OFFICE FEE: \$10 per show per horse/rider

Exhibitor Number: same number used for season for horse/rider combination.

NSF cheques are subject to a \$45 NSF fee

Limited **stalls available** for **\$40 / day** – Exhibitor must bring own shavings and **PLEASE** remove **ALL SHAVINGS** and manure and **SWEEP**

Note that Year-End awards will be presented only in classes with a minimum of 3 eligible riders. * Fun classes are not eligible for year end awards

Horse Show Rules and Information

- 1. Riding helmets must be worn by youth exhibitors (18 and under) at all times when in the ring, and when warming up.
- 2. Appropriate footwear, with a heel, (no running shoes) must also be worn by all show exhibitors.
- 3. Proof of insurance must be provided at time of entry.
- 4. Numbers will not be released until insurance is shown and entry forms signed.
- 5. All placings are final. Any interference with the judge's decisions will lead to the exhibitor's removal from that class or the show.
- 6. The show committee reserves the right to cancel classes.
- 7. Exhibitors must use appropriate tack for each class:
 - a. English class uses English tack
 - b. Western class uses Western tack.
- 8. Please bring a bucket for picking up your manure.
- 9. Dogs must be leashed at all times. Service Dogs exempt.
