Educator Theo Sabin
Meyer, after her marriage to
Ludwig G. Meyer, left teaching and began organizing.
Her success in founding the
Erie, PA chapter of the Women's

International League, attracted the attention of leaders in the AFL and the CIO. Meyer was recruited to use her skills to advocate for

PA, and fought for women's rights. She challenged the practice of sending children to jobs, instead of to school. She was also a spirited and courageous speaker. It is reported that she delivered remarks to President Franklin Delano Roosevelt, while he led the United States through the great depression and World War II (1933-45). Meyer's 20th century efforts to champion the rights of workers women and children inspires social justice reform today.
