

As of today, Gloucester County has 1209 positive cases and 4,034 negative tests of COVID-19. Pitman is now at 23 confirmed cases with men and women ranging in age from 23 to 85 years old. Sadly, the county today also confirmed that the 85 year old male from Pitman passed away on April 16th. Although his identity is not provided, our thoughts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

* Executive Order 130 permits municipalities to extend their grace periods for tax payments due May 1st to June 1st without local tax payers incurring any interest charges on the overdue payment. As a result of this order, the Borough of Pitman will be extending the grace period that normally would terminate on May 10th to Monday, June 1st. Any property tax payments not made prior to 2:00pm on Monday, June 1, 2020 will incur interest charges calculated back to May 1, 2020. Residents are reminded that payments can be made via mail, online, or by placing the payment in the drop box in the vestibule of Borough Hall. The Finance Office staff is working Monday through Thursday from 8:00am – 2:00pm and will process all payments.
