Thank You to all who have made a pledge of financial support to First Baptist for 2024! We are grateful for so many who faithfully support our work. As of November 26, we have



Our daily devotional booklets for the winter quarter are now available. You can pick up a copy on the table in the narthex or contact the church office if you would like to have your copy delivered to you.






