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## MUSIC CLASS

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## INTRO

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### MARCH LESSON PLAN

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The month of March, students will continue learning basics of music. This time it will consist of learning Harmony, Form, and Texture with a test on the last week. Various activities and videos will be shown in order for the students to understand those concepts. In all the classes, students will be taking notes.

#### Week 1:

Students will learn about Harmony

- A Power-point will be shown to help the students understand what harmony is
- Videos and activities, such as singing together, will be done in order to help them better understand the concepts of harmony such
- Certain parts of the Power-Point will be highlighted in order for the students to write them down and study

#### Pre-K and Kindergarten

- Mostly videos will be shown in order to catch their attention better and have a better understanding of music.
  - Activities and games will be done in order for them to understand rhythm, tempo and beat better.
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## Week 2:

Students will learn about Form

- Power-point will be shown as well as videos to help the students understand Form
- Students will receive instruction on how a worship song is built in class
- Certain parts of the Power-Point will be highlighted in order for the students to write them down and study

### Pre-K-Kindergarten

- Pre-K students will sing along with music or play music related games to practice tempo, rhythm, and beat.

## Week 3:

Students will learn about Texture

- Power-point and Videos will be shown to teach what texture is
- Songs and movie scores will be shown to explain texture to the students
- The students will be taking notes

### Pre-K-Kindergarten

- Pre-K will hear certain songs and try to dance to it depending how they feel the music should be danced.

## Week 4:

Test Day

Test days will be simple. I will grade the students separately one by one to see if they understand the concept of the lessons that were taught. They will be tested individually on harmony, form and texture.

- Harmony: Questions will be set to see if a student can understand harmony to a song (3 songs)
- Form: One by one, students will be asked questions about form (3 songs)
- Texture: (4 questions) regarding texture. Students have to understand how texture can affect the feeling of music.

Each question is worth 10 points leaving a total 100 if 10/10 are correct.
