CITY OF TWO HARBORS CHARTER COMMISSION

The City of Two Harbors is a home rule charter city. Home rule charters are, in effect, local constitutions. State laws give cities a wide range of discretion to draft charters that will meet the specific needs of the community.

The City of Two Harbors is seeking City residents who are interested in serving as a member of the City's Charter Commission. Through a process of recommendation by the Mayor and City Council, new members are officially appointed by the district court.

Since the City of Two Harbors already has a city charter in existence, the Charter Commission's statutorily prescribed duty is to study the local charter and government. Based on this, the group makes or accepts recommendations for any changes which may be deemed necessary and appropriate. The commission may propose charter amendments or changes as may be recommended by the commission, City Council or by petition of the City's residents.

Residents who are interested in serving on the Charter Commission should complete an Application to Join a City of Two Harbors Committee or Commission, available at City Hall, 522 1st Avenue, or found on the City's website at www.twoharborsmn.gov. Applications are to be submitted to info@twoharborsmn.gov, or to City Hall, 522 1st Avenue, Two Harbors, MN 55616.

Participation on this important commission requires a serious commitment to attending regularly scheduled monthly meetings with few absences.

Several North Shore state parks will have limited public access during special hunt on November 6 - 21, 2021

During a special hunt from November 6th - 21st to prevent overpopulation of deer and to protect resources, Gooseberry Falls, Split Rock Lighthouse, Tettegouche, Temperance River, Cascade River and Judge Mangle State Parks will be partially closed. Portions of each park will remain open to non-hunters during the hunt. Visitors are advised to wear blaze orange or brightly colored clothing if they will be in the park while the hunt is in progress. Visitors should also check for hunt-related information on the park website and at the park office when they arrive.

Hunts also will take place at other Minnesota state parks and recreation areas this fall, and access to the parks will vary. Some will remain open to all visitors, some will have limited public access and some will be open only to hunters with special permits. The deadlines have passed for youth and adults to apply for the permits to participate in these state park and recreation area hunts, which include regular firearms, muzzleloader and archery options.

"Too many of one animal or plant species in an area can start to throw off the balance of other species in that area," said Tavis Westbrook, a natural resource program coordinator with DNR's Division of Parks and Trails. "When there are too many deer in a park, they feed too much on certain trees and native plants, so occasionally we allow deer hunts as a way to protect natural resources."

The DNR thanks visitors for their patience and understanding during the hunts.
