Hearthstone | The History Museum at the Castle | Guided Appleton Bus Tour

AASD has partnered with The History Museum at the Castle and Hearthstone Historic House Museum to offer 2nd graders a local history field trip. This engaging adventure includes a guided tour of Hearthstone, a visit to the History Museum's exhibits, and an hour –long guided bus tour of historic Appleton sights (Many of the sites are connected to the *Hometown Histories* book).

Admission: \$6.50 per student (\$3 Hearthstone, \$3.50 History Museum & bus tour)

For History Museum: 1 chaperone for every 5 students is required and free; additional chaperones pay exhibit admission

For Hearthstone: 1 chaperone for every 10 students is required and free; additional chaperones pay regular admission
