This past week, our students took the Iowa Tests of Basic Skills to measure their academic achievement and growth from this past year. We use these tests to help us know how well our students are progressing and what we can do to improve our academic program. TUITION

A letter from our school board was sent home to families this week highlighting the need to raise our school's tuition by \$200 in the upcoming year. This will raise our tuition rate to \$4,000 for students in K-8. This comes to a \$20 / month raise for families on a 10 month payment plan. Please note that the national average elementary Catholic school tuition is \$4,400, and that the actual cost to educate each student is around \$5,400. We will still work hard to provide financial aid for qualifying families in need. Please let us know if you have any questions or concerns!

We are currently in need of a parent volunteer who would be interested in taking over our Box Tops coordinating.
