Board Structure and Bylaw Updates

Do our bylaws reflect our current Board structure?

Dres Zellweger made list of Board responsibilities that can be used to update our current Bylaws for ratification during a winter member meeting. The Board would like to update Board positions to rotate with a 3-year cycle, such that in any given year:

- A new Vice President is elected
- The Vice President becomes President
- The President becomes Past President
- The Past President rotates out
- All other Board positions are open for nominations and elections

The Board discussed recruitment of new Board members including potentially providing financial incentives (reduced membership fees) for Board participation. Sylvia Pacher will investigate how much these incentives may cost. The Board will highlight the benefits of Board participation at a Winter close-out meeting. They will also consider recruiting a new Member at Large for the next season.

The Board discussed making only two of three annual member meetings mandatory, with the Spring Meeting always being mandatory.

All proposed changes to the Bylaws will be collected for vote and ratification at an upcoming Member Meeting that has a quorum of attendees.
