General Supplies:

Sewing machine (preferably with some zig-zag and decorative stitches), needles, pedal, and power cord, thread and bobbin— decorative threads work for this

Walking foot is helpful but not required

Cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter with sharp blade

Pressing mat and iron, (one station will be provided in the classroom)

Press cloth, parchment paper, or silicone pressing sheet (parchment paper will be provided)

Pins, scissors for paper, shears, seam ripper

Extension Cord and/or power strip-you just can't be sure what you will need

Fan-just in case it's hot

Glue stick-suggested in the instructions, I didn't use one

Fusible web (Heat n Bond Lite is one example-choose your favorite)

Assorted Threads that coordinate with the fabrics used.

Night Owl Materials List:

Fusible fleece, 9" by 17" or slightly larger

Muslin, 9" by 17" or slightly larger

Backing fabric, 9" by 21" or slightly larger, plus extra for hanging sleeve, 4" by finished width of wall hanging

Up to 12 background fabrics, some can be repeated blues, greens, purples

1 owl body and moon fabric, about 4" by 5"

1 wing fabric

1 branch fabric

2 buttons for eyes, about 1/2 inch diameter

Thread, an assortment that coordinates with the colors of the fabrics chosen

Regular school glue stick-helpful but not required

Paper Back Fusible Web - 5" by 10"

Moonlight Moose Materials List:

Fusible Fleece, 11" by 17" or slightly larger

Muslin, 11" by 17" or slightly larger

Backing fabric, 11" by 21", plus extra for hanging sleeve, 4" by finished width of wall hanging
11 background and tree fabrics, the largest one is 6" by 11"
Moose and moon fabrics, largest is 5" square
Small amount of Paper Back Fusible Web for the moose and moon-5" by 8" (Heat n Bond Lite is one example-choose your favorite)
Thread, an assortment that coordinates with the colors of the fabrics chosen
Regular school glue stick-helpful but not required

Autumn Leaves Materials List:

Fusible fleece, 10"by 17" or slightly larger
Muslin, 10" by 17" or slightly larger
Backing fabric, 10" by 21" or slightly larger, plus extra for hanging sleeve, 4" by finished width of wall hanging
Paper Back Fusible Web for the leaves-about an 8" square (Heat n Bond Lite is one example-choose your favorite)
14 background fabrics at least 10" wide, largest is 6" by 10"
4 leaf fabrics-these are small
Thread, an assortment that coordinates with the colors of the fabrics chosen
Regular school glue stick-helpful but not required

Moonshadows Materials list:

4 blue fabrics for the sky and hills, at least 24 inches wide
2 gray fabrics for trees and moon, assorted sizes, trees are approximately 12" tall
2 purple fabrics for the mountains at least 24 inches wide
Fusible fleece, about 25" by 18"
Muslin pre-backing, about 25" by 18"
Backing Fabric, about 25" by 18", plus extra for hanging sleeve, 4" by finished width of wall hanging
Paper back fusible web-about 8" by 12"
Thread, an assortment that coordinates with the colors of the fabrics chosen
A dark colored pencil

Summer Dragonfly Materials list:

Fusible fleece, approximately 14" by 23"
Muslin pre-backing, approximately 14" by 23"
Backing, approximately 14" by 21", plus extra for hanging sleeve, 4" by finished width of wall hanging
Assorted yellow, orange, and purple fabrics at least 14" wide for the background
2 purple/dark blue fabrics for the dragonfly
Thread, an assortment that coordinates with the colors of the fabrics chosen
Paper back fusible web, about a 10" square

Serenity Materials list:

13 background fabrics that gradually change from one to another, some can be used more than once, the largest is 14" by 17", all are at least 14" wide
2 gray tree fabrics, the lighter one is 9" by 6", the darker one about 3" by 8"
Fusible fleece 14" by 23"
Muslin 14" by 23"

Paper back fusible web, about 8" by 11"
Assorted threads to match fabrics for decorative stitching
Backing fabric, at least 14" by 22"
Hanging Sleeve fabric, 3 1/2' by 14"

Preparing and cutting appliqué fabric pieces in advance will provide more time in class to get your wall hangings finished. Cutting the background pieces is not required in advance and can be done quickly in class. Cutting the background pieces oversized makes the process easier.
