We are proud to service the Mount Pleasant Township community. Your current service days for recycling and trash pickup are not changing. Bulk items will be collected on trash days the same week as your recycling. Follow these simple steps to ensure your waste is collected quickly and easily.

Curbside Waste Rules

Non-Acceptable Waste Items:

- × Steel drums
- × Asbestos
- × Pharmaceuticals
- × Ashes
- × Hazardous or bio-hazard material
- × Paint and solvents or any other liquids
- X Tires, lead-acid batteries and car parts
- X Items more than 50 pounds
- × Electronic waste
- X Items that do not fit into truck hopper
- ✓ Items containing Freon® must have it removed and tagged by a licensed technician

Recycling Rules

Acceptable Recyclable Items:

- ✓ Clean paper, cardboard and newsprint
- ✓ Rigid plastic food and beverage containers (#1 and #2)
- ✓ Steel, aluminum and bi-metal food and beverage containers
- ✓ Fold-top milk and soup cartons
- ✓ All items should be rinsed and free of contaminants

Non-Acceptable Items:

- × Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass and ceramics
- × Plastic items #3 through #7
- X Glass food and beverage containers (all colors)
- Containers with food and liquid residue remaining
- × Pizza boxes and wet paper products
- X Garden hoses
- × All metals except for those identified as acceptable

Yard & Leaf Waste

- ✓ Must be in biodegradable bags
- ✓ Weight not to exceed 50 pounds
- ✓ See schedule for collection days

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) & Electronics Waste

Acceptable Items (5 gallons of less):


- ✓ Paint latex and oil-based
- ✓ Paint thinners, gasoline, solvents
- ✓ Oil- and petroleum-based lubricants
- ✓ Ethylene glycol, antifreeze
- ✓ Pesticides, herbicides
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Mercury, mercury debris
- ✓ Light bulbs fluorescents, compact fluorescents (CFL), high-intensity discharge (HID) lamps

- ✓ Batteries lead-acid, alkaline, nicad
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Cleaners acidic and basic
- Resins and epoxy
- ✓ Electronics waste Limit 2 items at a time such as tube TVs or computer monitors, computers, VCR and DVD players, printers, fax machines, cable boxes, gaming equipment and similar electronic waste.

Only four holidays will delay service in 2022. Residents should call for electronics waste and household hazardous waste collection dates. Yard waste must be in biodegradable bags and be ready for collection by 6 a.m. on the designated collection days.



Cost of Services

- ✓ Regular services are \$18.53 per month, billed quarterly. Includes weekly household waste and every other week recycling collection.
- ✓ For seniors, service is \$16.68 per month, billed quarterly. Includes weekly household waste and every other week recycling collection.
- ✓ Waste sticker program entitles seniors to pay by the bag. You may obtain stickers from the township office or from Republic Services for a fee of \$18.75 per sleeve of 5 (tags) and attach to bag prior to collection. Sticker program includes weekly household waste and every other week recycling collection.
- ✓ Electronic waste and household hazardous waste pickup service is available in this program. Residents must call 724.887.9400 to schedule collection.
- ✓ Late and delinquent accounts will be assessed additional fees and/or have service suspended.
