

## Microblading Terms and Conditions and Policies

### **Patients who are contraindicated (cannot have treatment):**

- Under 18 years of age
- Diabetic
- Pregnant
- Glaucoma
- Actively taking blood thinners and cannot come off of them
- Skin conditions such as: eczema, psoriasis, severe rosacea, undiagnosed rashes or blisters
- Autoimmune deficiencies and conditions
- History of keloid scarring
- Patients on Accutane or taken Accutane within the last 12 months
- Transmittable blood conditions such as HIV or Hepatitis

### **Patients who may be contraindicated:**

- If you have an active illness such as flu or cold you need to reschedule
- If you are allergic to topical anesthetics and cannot handle the procedure without it
- Coumadin: amount of bleeding and response to topical epinephrine will determine coverage per appointment. If excessive bleeding occurs, extra sessions may be necessary to achieve desired outcome or the procedure may not be effective at all.
- History of cold sores (hsv) you need to pre treat with a medication such as Valtrex.
- Previous eyebrow tattoo work must be at least 75% faded. Pictures must be sent in prior to procedure or you must come by the office in person for evaluation if practitioner cannot see photos very well.
