SCHOOL BOARD NEWS

These are the UNOFFICIAL DRAFT MINUTES SUBJECT TO CHANGE AND BOARD APPROVAL, 2-6-102,104 MCA of the Regular November 21, 2016 School Board meeting:

- Chairman Lane Drury called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Roll was taken and it was established that a quorum was present. Chairman Drury modified the agenda to add and Informational item to be presented after the Superintendents report.
- Patrons and visitors were recognized.
- On motion by Tim Tande, seconded by Don Hagan, the minutes from the regular meeting on October 17, 2016, were approved unanimously as presented.
- The superintendent's report was discussed and is attached and made a part of these minutes by reference.
- Athletic Director Logan Brower presented a request by the Girls High School basketball coach for the Board to look into allowing 8th grade girls to play high school basketball for the 2016-2017 season. A special meeting will be held on November 29, 2016 at 7:30 to explore it further.
- On motion by Jesse Cole, and seconded by Bill Rask, the October 13, 2016 November 14, 2016 claims in the amount of \$42,414.40 were approved unanimously as presented.
- On motion by Bill Rask and seconded by Tim Tande, the Activities Report for the month of October, 2016 was approved unanimously as presented.
- Jesse Cole moved to offer Melissa Holum a Long Term Substitute contract for the remainder of the 2016-2017 school year. Don Hagan seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Bill Rask moved to hire Cale Handran for the 2016-2017 Jr. High basketball coach. Jesse Cole seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Don Hagan moved to include Kurt Nelson and Lyndsey Maldonado on the Substitute list for the 2016-2017 school year. Bill Rask seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Bill Rask moved to increase Kourtney Voorhees to full time janitor status. Tim Tande seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Tim Tande moved to allow Daniel Francis to work with Scott Farris doing custodial duties during the day, compensated by Vocational Rehab program. Bill Rask seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Don Hagan moved to approve the second reading of the 2016-2017 Teacher Handbook. Bill Rask seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Bill Rask moved to approve the purchase of a 12 month subscription to the APEX Comprehensive Courses and APEX tutorials. Tim Tande seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Sean Cromwell presented information about the status of our bus fleet and ideas for future district needs.
- Jesse Cole presented a parent concern regarding bullying and treatment of students towards each other.
- CTA Architects Engineers have asked the Board if they would give a letter stating if CTA met all of the District's needs and expectations in regards to the Boiler project. The Board agreed that this is something they would do as CTA more than met their expectations.
