



Undergraduate Student Travel Award in Honor of Dr. Nick Tolft
Sponsored by The Analytical Chemistry Division of the CIC

TERMS OF REFERENCE

This award was named in honor of Dr. Nick Tolft on the occasion of his passing in 2017. A long-serving member of the ACD executive, Dr. Tolft was passionate about the education and mentorship of undergraduate students in analytical chemistry.

The intent of the award is to honor outstanding senior undergraduate students in analytical chemistry, to encourage them into postgraduate studies and to expose them to a stimulating scientific environment at the annual Canadian Chemical Conference.

The Undergraduate Student Travel awards are open to all undergraduate students pursuing studies in the area of Analytical Chemistry and in attendance at a Canadian University. Each winner is expected to give a poster or oral presentation of his/her work at the CSC conference.

The number of awards given each year and their individual value are to be determined by ACD executive dependent on the annual budget. Taken under consideration will be the number of nominations and the distances from the conference site. It is the intent of the Division to have the awards cover as much of each winner's expenses as possible. It is hoped the winner's department will cover the balance.

Each research supervisor may nominate one candidate per competition. The application package should contain:

- a curriculum vitae of the student,
- a copy of the student's academic transcript, and
- one supporting letter (submitted by the supervisor)
