Congregational Council Minutes - June 13, 2021

ATTENDANCE: All were present

CARES AND CONCERNS: Praying for Jenny Scott's son Ross and daughter-in-law Lindsay carrying baby to term with severe birth defects who isn't expected to survive, Buddy Hydrick who completed chemotherapy and radiation, Buddy Hydrick's cousin David, Sheila Starkey's sister Pam, and Mary Frances Sease.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA: Approved with no additions **ADOPTION OF MINUTES:** Approved with no corrections **REPORTS:**

- Pastor Gina: Written report received. Mt. Hermon has received 25 new members since Pastor Gina was installed in October 2018. Memorial Day service held on May 31, 2021. Samantha Bucknam will be recognized on June 27th as a high school graduate. Pastor Gina will teach an adult class during Vacation Bible School July 20–22.
- Treasurer: No written report due to Parker out of town with no internet service.
- Financial Secretary: Written report received for May 2021 but April's report not included. We will ask Annette to provide for July council meeting. Mother's Day bulletin collected \$750.00 and Father's Day bulletin \$415.

Team Reports/Recommendations:

Worship: Written report received from April 27th meeting but not May 25th meeting. A new hymnal supplement, "All Creation Sings" will be used in worship services. Ruthie would like to have two summer candlelight concerts in the Fellowship Hall but they will not be live streamed.

Outreach: Written report received from April and May Zoom meetings. The Red Cross changed the date of our next blood drive to August 1st from 11:30 AM to 4 pm. The Food Pantry received a donation of Bibles to share with families and also a donation of frozen food. The Free Garage Sale will be held Friday, December 3rd and the Angel Tree gift distribution will be held on Wednesday, December 15th. Thanks to everyone who donated their time and energy for the Adopt-A-Highway cleanup and another one is scheduled for August 21st. The Outreach Team presented their new brochure for Mt. Hermon to Church Council for approval. Church Council reviewed the brochure and discussed corrections and changes to be made to the brochure. Church Council asks Outreach Team to address our recommendations and bring the revised brochure back to Church Council for approval.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Building Renovation & Repair Task Force: Our church received an anonymous gift of a lawn mower. Task Force has met and is brainstorming a list of repairs and renovations to bring to Church Council.
- 2. Health & Safety Task Force: Members of the task force will be recognized and thanked for their time during church service on June 20th.




