Letter to Experienced Game Show Riders

We would like to thank all of you 'Horse Show Gamers' for coming to the Stanley Rodeo Games every year. It is your participation that has made our show so popular. We have an amazing number of horses to get through 7 games in 7 ½ hours and yet we still give each rider more "event riding time" than most shows.

We will continue to use the "rodeo game format" to give you the most meaningful riding time possible as well as the most "event riding time"! A good example of this is the popular "Equine Extreme" event. With entering the arena only once, you can round 5 barrels, cross a bridge, cross logs, jump a jump and go through a key way. Another example is the "Rodeo Double" event where you do two events but only enter the arena once, thus doubling your "event riding time".

We are asking you to help keep the 7<sup>th</sup> event in the show by riding your horse into the "in-chute" near the "in-gate" when your name is called for "on-deck". This seems like a small thing to some riders, but the show should be over by 3:00 p.m. and we should vacate the arena by 3:30 p.m. If each rider saved a mere ten seconds to get through the "in-gate", with 60 participants and 7 events, then ten seconds times 60 times seven would equal 70 minutes for the day. So if every rider was well in the "in-chute" when their ride is called, we would save 1 hour and ten minutes. This gives us the additional 7<sup>th</sup> event. Please help, everyone wants to ride and no one wants to wait.

As always, young and greenhorn riders are always welcome and encouraged to come and have fun!

## BARRELS [To Start at 2:00 p.m.]

NOTE: All riders who wear a safety helmet in each class entered will have their name entered into 2 separate age group drawings: 17 & Under; 18 & Over.

**RULES-COWBOY DRESS CODE:** Western Hat or Helmet must be worn, (We strongly recommend all riders wear helmets).

Button down Western Shirt (long or short sleeves), Jeans/Riding Pants or Riding Skirt, and Western Riding Boots must be worn. Vests and ties welcome.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Any rider age 17 and under wearing a helmet for each event will be entered into a drawing.

High Point Awards! Custom Belt Buckles will be given out to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each age group. Buckles will be awarded to Horse and Rider at the Saturday Night Rodeo Performance. NOTE: Participation in the Rodeo Awards Ceremony is REQUIRED to receive a buckle. Also note that the Cowboy

Dress Code is REQUIRED to be in a PRCA Rodeo Arena. Since the High Point Winners are participating in a PRCA Program, the riders are expected to ride in the Grand Entrance with the Cowboys and Cowgirls at the beginning of the performance (dress code enforced).

RODEO GAME RULES

- A Horse may be used only once in any event.
- No running through the gate at the start or finish of an event.
- Lead line riders will receive one participation ribbon for the day.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed in staging area or stands.
- Other than "lead line" there can be NO physical presence or help past the time line.
- The next rider must be in the "in chute" when his/her name is called or the next rider will be called... ("in the hole" name will be called prior).
- At the judges' discretion, a rider may be disqualified for horse abuse, unsportsmanlike conduct (including foul language), lack of control or unsafe situation such as an unruly horse.
- A rider may request that a jump be laid on the ground with 5 seconds added to their time.
- No whipping or spurring in front of the cinch.
- A Western Hat or helmet must be worn (we strongly recommend all riders wear helmets).
- Button down western shirts (Long or short sleeves), jeans/riding pants or riding skirt, and western riding boots with at least a ½ inch heel must be worn. Vest or ties are welcome.
- One (1) second penalty for losing hat if it falls to the ground within the gates.
- No re-rides for broken equipment or fallen horses. No re-ride due to equipment failure if the time clock has started.
- Entry period ends one event prior.
- High point ties will be broken by the barrel event.
- In the event of ties for the class, the tie is to be run off between the riders involved – the winner of the tie must have ran-off within two (2) seconds of his/her original time or the run-off must be held again. OPTIONAL: if both riders agree, the tie will be broken by the flip of a coin.
- Any breaking of the pattern means disqualification. Circling of the props more than once, backing, changing of direction, etc. is not considered breaking of pattern as the time will take care of that.
- No running your horse in the staging area, there is a 'sand warm up area in the parking lot.
- Any act of discourtesy or disobedience towards any Rodeo Game Official or Worker, in or out of the arena, will result in disqualification for the duration of the Rodeo Game Show.
- Any grievance must be submitted in writing to the judge and may not be discussed with the volunteers/workers in the announcer's stand.
- If the timer fails, the rider has an option of two re-rides. If more obstacles are knocked over on the first re-ride then the initial ride then a second re-ride can be taken with the later time used.
