There are many ways to be a part of the fun and learning:

- 1 Any lesson student who has ridden with us for at least 6 months is invited to apply to our LSF Show Team. We have several options for paid show leases on our school horses. We show at dressage, western dressage, ranch, and open shows. Riders are required to attend regular lessons, and we offer coaching at the event and hauling for a fee.
- 2 Any active student on their own horse with us, either in training or in lessons, is also invited to apply for the LSF Show Team. We show at dressage, western dressage, ranch, and open shows. Riders are required to attend regular lessons, and we offer coaching at the event and hauling for a fee.
- 3 The Teenybopper Show Team is a unique experience available for 3 riders who have been active in Mytalisha's Dream Teenyboppers for at least 1 season. Riders are partnered with one of LSF's proven show horses. This experience is unique in that these riders are sponsored, meaning the riders are only responsible for paying their entry and stall fees. We can even help with show clothes if needed. Teenyboppers show at the Bit and Spur regular (WSCA) shows and possibly Wild Bills if our schedule allows, right along side the rest of our LSF Show Team.
