At 6:08 pm the meeting was called to order. The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 pm.

AGENDA:

I. Acceptance of the Minutes

The Secretary will complete the August Minutes and send them to the Board via Google Groups and once reviewed and approved they will be posted on Natickgreen.org.

II. Maintenance Report

In Mike's absence, Nadine presented the maintenance report:

- A. Completed one renovation and working on another renovation.
- B. Deck staining and painting: Right Track painters are scheduled to start the last two buildings: 2-4 and 6-8 Post Oak Lane. Weather could be an issue.
- C. Electrical panel project: Dave Cushing is working with Eversource on scheduling the additional half day of work at Post Oak #2 to #8.
- D. Stairs project: Hulbig Construction completed the steps at buildings 5,7,9 & 11 Post Oak. The railings at 1,3,9 & 11 Silver Hill are being re-painted.
- E. The pool is closed and winterized.

- F. H.S. Awning (our awning vendor) may have a solution to the lettering problem. It would involve adding a panel with the street address (black with white lettering) that would be fastened to the existing awning. Mike/Nadine will follow-up.
- G. Mike met with Brian Nelson of Metrowest Engineering. They walked the property and discussed the sequence of events to begin the parking lot and sidewalk potential 2022 project.
- H. Mike is currently interviewing candidates for the open cleaning/landscape position (to replace Francis). Former Maintenance employee Joey Angell has been rehired on a temporary basis. Also, Heli Souza informed Mike that he will be retiring in May 2021.
- I. There was a water main leak in the parking lot at 9 Silver Hill on Labor Day weekend. Russo Brothers were called-in to do the repair at a cost of \$6,557.50. McNulty will repair the asphalt.
- J. Maintenance has completed the walkway behind 6 & 8 Post Oak with reclaimed granite from the step project.

- A. A MOTION was adopted for the "Natick Green Election of Trustees in Lieu of an Annual Meeting" as the plan for carrying out the election of Trustees in lieu of any 2020 Annual Meeting of Unit Owners.
- B. Dumpster camera update: Brian Bishop (who was referred to us by Dave Cushing) is out of town so Nadine will follow-up with him as soon as he is available.
- C. Buildium software: Buildium will not accommodate our request of sending us a monthly invoice rather than charging our debit card. The Trustees asked Nadine if Buildium's services are still needed, and what would be the impact if we cancelled the service. The Association needs to know who owns the data, where it is kept, and the procedure to discontinue the service. Nadine will prepare a breakdown of this information for the next Board meeting.
