Please be sure you select the correct performance since there are no refunds.

If your dancer is only in Act 1 or Act 2 (see page 4 for line up) and plans to occupy a seat during the act they are not performing in, please purchase a ticket for them when you place your order. We will need you to fill out a dancer ticket



credit form with the seat and section number on it. We will refund the amount of the ticket back to your account. If you plan on using your ticket credit towards June charges we will need your form by May 31st. Any credit forms submitted after May 31st will have their credits available to use toward summer classes or the 2017-18 season. If your child is performing in both Act 1 and Act 2 they are not eligible for a ticket credit since they will be backstage during the duration of the performance.

Also please note that the dancer's tickets may not be used by anyone other than the dancer.

The Clark State Box office will still be handling phone and in person sales and will be selling tickets the night of the performances. You can order tickets by phone, toll free 1-866-PAC-TKTS. Or purchase your tickets in person at the Clark State Box Office at 300 South Fountain Avenue, Springfield, OH.

Ticket prices will be \$10 - \$16\* depending on location. In anticipation of a large crowd for our single performance this year, seats will also be available in the orchestra pit for \$16. Box seats will also be available for \$30.

Tickets for the 1 p.m. solo and duet/ specialty performance on Saturday, June 17 will be \$12. (THIS IS NOT THE SATURDAY MAIN SHOW PERFORMANCE! This performance is for our Dance Force dancers to showcase their solos,

Box seats are \$33, with the Ticketmaster charge added. There is also a \$3.00 processing fee per order. (Specialty Performance Tickets are \$12.00 (\$15.00 with the ticket fee added on).

The admission that you pay along with the recital fee allows us to pay for the rental of the auditorium, stagehand and security salaries, box office services and props, chaperones, all of which help to make for the most enjoyable performance possible.

Ria wrote, "I want to thank everyone, my family, friends, and all the people at the dance studio who made this year a great experience!"


## HAVE YOU TRIED A SMOOTHIE?
