AROUND THE NATION

The season is at the end of the first quarter as we drive toward the first college football playoff. Here is a quick analysis of the leading contenders for the four playoff spots.

Florida State ... the Seminoles have looked only decent so far, but it is tough to see them losing more than once (which should get them in unless you believe four teams will go unbeaten)

Oklahoma-Baylor Winner ... these two teams can light up the scoreboard and in to-day's offense driven game that might be enough to get the winner to the playoff. The teams meet on November 8^{th} .

Oregon ... the Ducks look unstoppable on offense right now, but must solve their Stanford dilemma.

Alabama-Auburn Winner ... the SEC West is brutal, but it is not unreasonable to see these two squads come into the Iron Bowl with no more than one loss each. If that is the case, a playoff spot might be on the line (pending a win in the SEC title game obviously).

This week's big games include **Auburn at Kansas State** (Thursday). **Virginia Tech hosts Georgia Tech** in a game that often determines the ACC Coastal. **Florida visits Alabama** in a huge SEC game. Finally, **Miami travels to Nebraska**. The two had storied post-season games in the 1980s and 1990s, but this is the first regular season meeting of the two schools since 1976.

GAME-OF-THE-WEEK



FLORIDA AT ALABAMA



The Florida Gators (2-0) travel to Bryant-Denny Stadium to take on the Crimson Tide of Alabama (3-0) in a key Southeastern Conference contest. Florida is trying to rebound from a disappointing 2013 season that saw UF limp to a 4-8 season.

Bama seems to have settled on Blake Sims as their starting QB over Jacob Coker due in part to his mobility and his knowledge of the offense. RB's T.J. Yeldon, Derrick Henry and WR Amari Cooper are the offensive stars while the defense continues to be strong in Tuscaloosa.

Florida goes as QB Jeff Driskel goes. If he stays healthy and plays smart, Florida can win every game on the schedule but he has not proven he can do either, thus the situation Florida seems to find themselves in these days. Defensively the Gators have a ton of talent and potentially can become dominant.

Alabama leads the all-time series vs Florida 23-14 with 7 of those contests taking place in the SEC Championship Game (1992-2009) but Florida is 9-7 vs Alabama since 1987. Florida fans have come to expect championships due to the success that Steve Spurrier (122-27-1 .817 with 5 SEC Championships and 1 National Championship) and Urban Meyer (65-15 .813 with 2 SEC Championships and 2 National Championships) had as the their head coach. Look for the heat to increase on Will Muschamp after Alabama wins a close game at home.

WINNINGEST HEAD COACH AT ALL 129 NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL BOWL SUBDIVISION SCHOOLS

Below we list the coach with the most victories at each NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision school through 2013. The all-time win totals are adjusted for any wins that might have been forced to be forfeited or vacated by actions from the NCAA or by the conference. Won-loss records shown are just for each coaches' W-L record at that particular school and do not include his entire coaching record that he accumulated at other schools. This list is ONLY for one coach from each of the 129 NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision schools with the most victories to compare against each other. Active coaches are listed in BOLD CAPS. Western Michigan has 2 coaches tied for the most wins at that school, thus the reason for 130 names. Bear Bryant has the most wins at both Alabama (232) and Kentucky (60), George Welsh has the most wins at both Virginia (134) and Navy (55), Steve Spurrier has the most wins at both Florida (122) and South Carolina (77) and Gary Pinkel has the most wins at both Toledo (73) and Missouri (102).

Now that the NCAA has lifted the post season ban levied against Penn State, the next question is, should they restore the 111 wins they stripped from Joe Paterno? The NCAA stripped Joe Paterno of those 111 victories from 1998-2011 thus lowering his all-time record from 409-136-3 .749 to 298-136-3 .685. Below we show his on-the-field record and then show the seasons (1998-2011) where his wins were stripped away.
