## Teaching/Club time

### Emcee

Learn effective strategies that speed up the pace, decrease distractions and discipline problems, prepare for the next event, and redeem the time.

### Memory Verse

Need to learn the ins and outs of teaching the memory verse? There's an "IPEAR" for that (if this does not make sense to you, you should really consider taking this class :) ! Make scripture memory a vibrant part of your class using a simple 5-step method.

### Bible Lesson 1- Using the Story

Bible stories should never be boring. It's up to the teacher to make the Bible come alive for the kids in your ministry! Learn tips for making a Biblical narrative an interactive and exciting experience for volunteers and children alike.

### Bible Lesson 2 Applications

Did you know that you can turn any Bible story into a Bible Lesson? Come to this class to learn practical and innovative ways to prepare and present a Bible Lesson so that your students will apply the Word of God in their own lives.

### Bible Lesson Invitation

Giving the invitation and guiding a child to the Savior (counseling) is the highlight of the club hour. We are going to break it down and provide practical tips to help you gain confidence for giving a clear invitation with every lesson.

### Guiding A Child to the Savior pt 1

Are you energetic about the time right after the Bible Lesson when you are one on one with a child to talk about their spiritual condition? Learn the basics for how to guide children to Christ with clarity and discernment.

### Guiding ACTTS pt 2

The most important thing you could ever do for children is guide them to the Savior. In this class session you will learn how to build confidence in working with children after the invitation as you are used by God to lead the child to the Savior. Review "what if" scenarios and put what you are learning by practicing with guidance with others.

### Wordless Book Framework

Can you organize and clearly communicate the Gospel to children? Understanding these essential pieces can help you focus every area of your ministry around a clear communication of the Gospel to children as well as to adults. (Great for all, especially Bible teachers)
