Reverend Joe S. Green is the founder and executive director of RSCM which is governed by a Board of Directors consisting of 13 members who bring expertise from ministry, military, industry, KALB-TV management, correctional facility operation, banking, Rapides Parish Public Schools and entrepreneurial business ownership.

From 1993 to the present, RSCM has received grants from the Department of Education that helped train staff and continue operating after-school programs. In 1997 and 1998, Rapides Station Community Ministries, Inc expanded its services to include senior citizens and physically challenged adults. RSCM collaborated with Saint Mathew Baptist Church and the Robert Wood Foundation to establish a community of 80 interfaith volunteers. This program was called Faith In Action which provided basic services to elderly community residents and established a strong framework for community intervention that continues today.

Rapides Station Community Ministries, Inc. has an outstanding reputation in the community for communicating well with the populace in the lower socioeconomic income level.
