

Mission Grant Application

Dear Brothers and Sisters, Please spend a moment of your time with our NWD mission statement:

The NWD-LCMS exists to encourage, network and equip Lutheran congregations of the NWD-LCMS to vigorously make known the love of Christ.

Offering a **Mission Grant** is a significant way for us to encourage and equip you to vigorously make known the love of Christ.

Grant Details

- 1. This is a Mission Grant the purpose is to encourage and support *local outreach and evangelism* to make known the Gospel to those not Christian or not church members.
- 2. The grant process is competitive. Grants will range between \$200 to \$10,000. This year we have \$18,000 to distribute. This means that there may be two or three larger grants or numerous smaller ones or a combination of both.
- 3. Grant requests must be received by November 24, 2021. Recipients will be announced by January 1, 2022.
- 4. Grant requests will be evaluated according to their outreach/evangelism potential. Tell us how your project directly ties to local missions/Gospel outreach. Examples: canvas the community and give away t-shirts; hire a preschool teacher; develop a marketing video; share a youth worker with another congregation; expand VBS to include intentional outreach goals; host a community youth event; develop radio commercials or Facebook advertisements; host a Community Christmas Event; etc.
- 5. Infrastructure costs are not disallowed, see #1 and #4.

- 6. Congregations with means are expected to offset their project costs. However, the purpose of the grant is to help fund projects that otherwise would not happen. Therefore, a lack of congregational funding is not a deterrent to being awarded a grant.
- 7. This grant must be used by December 31, 2022.
- 8. Churches may apply for one grant each calendar year. Application for a previously funded idea at the same location will receive lower consideration.
- 9. Funding for one-time events may be submitted.
- 10. The application needs to be signed by the pastor and the person directing the project.
- 11. Combining NWD Grants with Thrivent/other agencies is encouraged.
- 12. Commit to providing a brief evaluation of the event.
