In this class, you will finish a dichroic pendant with assorted tiny beads, Swarovski flatback crystals.

“Almost Instant Gratification Cabochons and Pendants”

In this class, students will be creating unique artistic cabochons for pendants, bead embroidery, etc. Students will have enough supplies to make 10+ different size and shape cabochons, 4 of which have chains included. Shapes include circle, oval, triangle and rectangle. Students will have choice of 2 pair of 12 mm post earrings or one barrette setting with five 12 mm circles. Most pendant settings and chain come in two finishes, Silver and antiqued Bronze.
