SUPERVISORS - Agenda item #14 Pulled, #32 Passed

[Apr 7] At Tuesday's meeting of the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors (BoS), agenda item 14 was pulled by the applicant (Fesler) making the request due to "personal reasons and health issues". At issue was a request by the applicant to rescind recorded certificates of compliance for twelve lots due to a lawsuit brought against the property owner by the Sierra Club. The item will be brought back when and if Mr. Fesler reapplies. Under agenda item 32 - an update from the Ad Hoc Fire Committee evaluating fire protection service by special districts within the County - the Board voted 5-0 to adopt the proposed funding policy for Independent Special Districts while receiving and filing the update. No further direction was given to staff. This decision formally shuts the door on any hopes any of the fire districts might have had regarding reevaluation of the percentage of property taxes allocated to them by the County based on state law (most notably AB 8 and Prop 13).

Work will continue on the County's plan for services when/if special district fire services fail throughout the County. To date, the Cayucos Fire District divested and the County took on the responsibility to provide those services.
