



Please be aware that **space is limited**. Application deadline is extended to **May 31, 2021**.

We are cautiously optimistic that we will be able to get all the fantastic Artists and Makers together on Seminary Ave this September. That being said, we cannot predict what the situation will look like then. We are keeping in close contact with the Hopewell Borough Administrator regarding the town's COVID-19 guidelines. We are planning for the show to go on, but we will not know how the pandemic has evolved until closer to the date of the show.

Due to this uncertainty, we are doing things a little differently this year. There will be a \$10 non-refundable application fee due upon submission of your application. This will allow us to keep the behind-the-scenes operations running and start promoting the show. If accepted to the show, an additional \$75 booth fee will be due July 16<sup>th</sup>. We must receive the booth fee by the deadline to secure your spot in the show.

We hope this will help alleviate refund issues in the event the show must be cancelled due to COVID-related reasons. We are crossing our fingers and we look forward to receiving your applications! Here's to another fabulous year of Handmade Hopewell.

#### **WHAT:**

This event is juried, featuring fine arts and craft. Also exhibiting will be artisans who handcraft consumable products such as tea, honey, jam, soap and similar products. Not accepted are items embellished or made from commercially available kits, plans, patterns, imports, factory-made or assembled items. In the effort to provide a diverse and balanced show, some categories may be more competitive than others. Please visit our website, Facebook or Instagram to get a good sense of the type of show we strive to create.

#### **WHO:**

One does not have to be a resident of Hopewell to apply. We encourage Makers from both near and far to join us! One does have to be present in order to sell, so please do not send anyone in your place. Artisans making consumable packaged products will be accepted, **food vendors will not**. New and emerging artists are encouraged to apply!

Seminary Avenue between Broad Street and Columbia Avenue, Hopewell, NJ 08525

**WHEN:**

**Date Change**, due to COVID restrictions

Sunday, September 12, 2021 from 10:00am-4:00pm

Set up: 7:45am-9:30am

Break down: 4:00pm-5:00pm

Event will be held Rain or Shine. We always hope for Shine, but Rain is a possibility.

*Upon acceptance to this show, artists must be prepared for any weather conditions. Artists who fail to show the day of the event will forfeit the opportunity to participate in future shows. There will be no refunds in the event promoters cancel the show due to severe weather conditions. Severe weather includes dangerously heavy wind, lightning, rain or any other weather condition that may jeopardize the safety of vendors or customers. There will be no rain date.*

**HOW:**

- 4 Digital Images (3 examples of work to be sold, 1 booth shot) (300DPI for promo purposes) Do not send printed images (hard copies), they cannot be used for promo purposes!
  - **Participants may only exhibit the type and quality of work shown in their supplied images.**
- Complete and sign application
- Application fee check of \$10.00 (made out to Beth Ann Designs).
- If accepted into the show, booth fee check of \$75.00 (made out to Beth Ann Designs) will be due by July 16<sup>th</sup>.

Again, new emerging artists are encouraged to apply.
