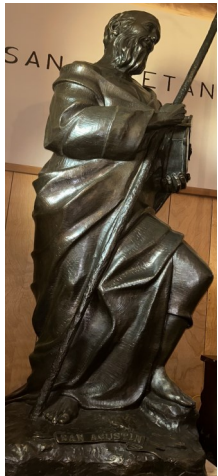


El Santuario de los Pobladores — Dedicated to the Mysteries of the Rosary



Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. The plaques will have a significant placement in the Santuario courtyard as you enter. This phase will begin in the spring of 2024.

This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine that has been moved to its permanent home at the Sanuario along with the Holy Family statue. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio. In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Santuario and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. MASS THEME

Theme: Awareness of God's Presence

Our presence here today puts us in the place of the crowds on the shore of Lake Gennesaret (the Sea of Galilee). We are in the presence of God, listening to God's word, attuned to what it can teach us. But Jesus calls us to more than wading in the shallow shoreline. He calls us to deep water as well, to the depths of our faith, to the depths of our being. It can be as scary as the deep end of a pool when you are learning to swim. But we have Jesus' words to assure us: "Do not be afraid" (Luke 5:10). Even far from shore, let us respond as Isaiah did: "Here I am!" (Isaiah 6:8).



BIBLICAL COMMENTARY

FIRST READING

Is 6:1-2A, 3-8 [Call of Isaiah]

When they are called by the Lord, both Isaiah and Peter initially insist that they are unworthy. After Isaiah calls himself unclean, an angel touches his mouth with an ember from the altar, purging him of his sin. Jesus doesn't explicitly absolve Peter of his sins, but he responds to Peter's protestations by saying, "Do not be afraid" (Luke 5:10), reassuring him that his sinfulness is not a deal-breaker. He wants Peter to be a fisher of others, despite his being a sinful man. We are sinners as well, but that doesn't mean Jesus wants us to wait until we are perfect before responding to his call. That would be an awfully long wait! "Do not be afraid," Jesus tells us now. Just follow.

SECOND READING

1 Cor 15:1-11 or 15:3-8, 11 [Content of the Good News]

We are not told what Jesus taught the crowds when he was a short distance from the shore. But when he finished, he asked Peter to "put out into deep water" to catch fish (Luke 5:4). Assuredly, it made sense to go out to deeper water to find more fish, but it also foreshadowed what Peter would come to find out over the next few years. Peter would get into deep water—sometimes literally!—in following Jesus on his mission.

For Your Information

Saint Valentine's day is coming!

Something that surprises me is the way that we can know who the saints are without actually knowing their story and why the church honors them. Saint Valentine is especially interesting to me. Being that he died in the year 269, it is tough for us to really know a lot about him... but there are stories and legends of his life. This one in particular stuck out to me.

Saint Valentine the Patron Saint of Marriage

Hi, I'm Saint Valentine. I lived a long, long time ago when Claudius II was the ruler of Rome. There were two important things to know about this king. First, Claudius II did not like Christians. Second, he loved having lots of soldiers to fight in his wars! Claudius II thought having soldiers for his wars was so important that he made a law that people couldn't get married. Claudius II thought that if young boys got married and had families they would not want to go off and fight in his wars. This made things really tricky for the Christians following God. First, they knew that God wanted them to worship Him, not the false gods of Claudius II. Second, they knew that God wanted them to get married and start families. I, Saint Valentine, had the special job of being God's helper during this time. I was a priest, so I would marry the men and women who wanted to get married. This is why I am called the patron saint of love and marriage.

The Beauty of Marriage today

Times have changed but not that much. It can be really tough teaching our children about the beauty of marriage in a world that is so very confused. Saint Valentine's Day can be a perfect day to show and remind kids of the beautiful gift of marriage.
