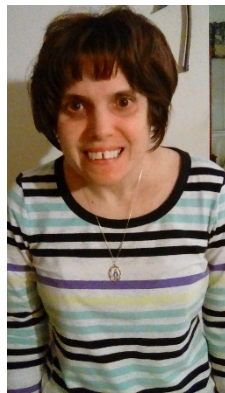

Instruction for the Mass from the official Roman Missal **(on Altar): The role of the Priest (in Red) and the People (In Black) at Mass:** starting Eucharistic Prayer again: (people's response in bold, *my notes in italic*)

The Liturgy of the Eucharist:

In all Masses, the Priest celebrant is permitted to sing parts of the Eucharistic Prayer provided with musical notation below, especially the principal parts. In Eucharistic Prayer I, the Roman Canon, the words included in brackets may be omitted. EUCHARISTIC PRAYER I OR THE ROMAN CANON (Cont.)

Commemoration of the Living. Remember, Lord, your servants **N. and N. The Priest joins his hands and prays briefly for those for whom he intends to pray. Then, with hands extended, he continues:** and all gathered here, whose faith and devotion are known to you. For them, we offer you this sacrifice of praise or they offer it for themselves and all who are dear to them, for the redemption of their souls, in hope of health and well-being, and paying their homage to you, the eternal God, living and true. **Within the Action. Celebrant or one concelebrant** In communion with those whose memory we venerate, especially the glorious ever-Virgin Mary, Mother of our God and Lord, Jesus Christ, † and blessed Joseph, *her* Spouse, your blessed Apostles and Martyrs, Peter and Paul, Andrew, (to be continued: The Liturgy of the Eucharist)

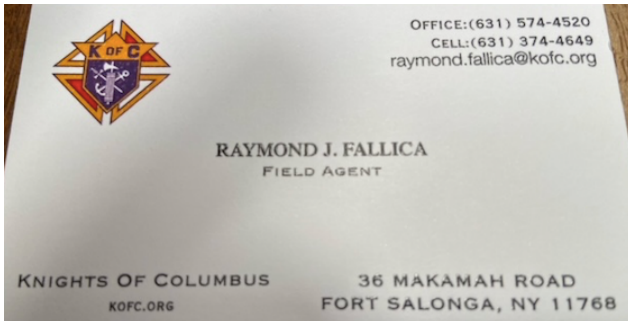
