The next meeting of the Board of Trustees will be held on **Wednesday, January 7, 2015 at 8:00 p.m.** at Village Hall.

In addition to our regular monthly business, there will be a public hearing on the tentative Village budget for fiscal year 2015/2016. I am pleased to advise that financially we are in good shape with a continued surplus of funds and positive operating cash flow. As such, we are pleased to advise that it is this board's intention not to increase taxes for a second year in a row. We are working hard to improve the quality of life and added benefits of living in our community while maintaining a firm handle on expenses. Copies of the proposed budget are available upon request at Village Hall.

In a continued effort to further enhance security within the village, the Board of Trustees is presently examining the addition of a private security patrol currently approved and instituted in Hewlett Bay Park and Hewlett Neck. We hope that this patrol (which would be approved on a trial basis) in conjunction with the already approved electronic measures will add to our intensified efforts to keep Woodsburgh safe and crime free.
