Historic Occoquan is an original 18th-century mill town nestled on the banks of the Occoquan River, just 30 miles south of Washington, D.C.

Designated a Virginia historic landmark in 1983, Occoquan today has successfully combined nearly 300 years of history with the modern attractions of shopping and dining. Occoquan offers a walkable downtown experience with everything from antiques, arts, and crafts to fashions and fine dining.
