What topics will be covered in this training?

The legal status of abortion, the biblical basis for the sanctity of human life, the woman & man with a crisis pregnancy, the nature of a crisis, counseling the client with the negative pregnancy test and abstinence counseling, the role of the Gospel, men's ministry, STIs, types of and complications of abortion, and prenatal development.

Where is the Atlantic LC Clinic located?

Who should get trained?

This training is required for those interested in serving in the following client contact roles: Peer Counselor, Receptionist, Education Facilitator, Abortion Recovery Support, Student Education Team, Nurses, Sonographers, Men's Ministry, Boutique Coordinator. However, it is open for all to attend.

What is the time commitment for a volunteer?

LC Clinic's Atlantic office will begin offering daytime & evening hours (Monday & Wednesday 1-6pm).

If you'd like to serve on the Client Contact Team, we ask you be able to volunteer several hours at a time on a consistent weekly or bi-weekly basis. There are other volunteer positions that are seasonal or periodic.

What are my gifts?

Not all volunteers wish to work with those in crisis or mentor clients. Some are more suited to administrative or clerical work; others enjoy helping with fundraisers; still others have special gifts, such as technical support or intercession. We will work with you to discover a meaningful way to serve through the ministry of LC Clinic.

If I train, am I obligated to volunteer in the clinic?

No. If you complete the training and are not comfortable interacting with clients, we will gladly work to find a more suitable role for you. Even if you never work in the clinic, the principles you learn in training will assist you in everyday living and equip you to more effectively protect the sanctity of human life.

What if I don't want to work with clients?

If you are interested in serving in a non-client contact volunteer position, you will be trained appropriately on an informal basis. Simply contact us today to get started!
