Tech Tips

During a restoration or just doing some maintenance did you find that the holes in the sheet metal were stripped so you could not tighten that screw that held on that door garnish molding, the plate for the door garnish or any other piece held by a sheet metal screw?

An easy way to repair this is to use a thin cotter pin, about an inch long (longer will be ok) .

Spread the cotter pin a little and cut the long end even with the short end. Then bend over the ends at a 90 degree angle, about 1/4 to 3/8 of an inch.

Insert the cotter pin in the hole. The bent ends will prevent the cotter pin from falling through the hole. Put on the piece you are working with and screw in the old sheet metal screw for a good tight fit of the screw.

Remember, use a thin cotter pin as too thick a pin will prevent the screw from going into the hole.


