- Comfortable Tour Buses will be utilized each day for all out of town events. Buses for Bath (Mon) and for Portsmouth (Wed) board at 8 am, and for the NE Baked Bean Supper (Tues) at 4 pm. For non-bean-lovers, other savory homemade-in-Maine dishes will be available.
- Dinner Monday is on your own. Order off the menu, get separate checks. Restaurant specializes in Lobster and other Maine seafood, but there are many other menu choices. Go for a huge down-east clambake feast, or have a small bowl of chowdah.
