



Don Franklin Masters, age 81, of Caseville, died Thursday, October 7, 2010 at Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe.

Don was born in Middlesbrough, Kentucky on March 27, 1929 to the late Walton and Cornie (Chadwell) Masters. He lived in Kentucky until joining the US Navy in 1948. He moved to Detroit following his time in the Navy. There he met and married Dolores J. Chrzanowski on October 1, 1949.
