

## DO YOU OWN A SUPERDOG??????

You may think so, but how do you know????

Come to the Clark County Event Center in Ridgefield Washington (The Fairgrounds) at 17402 NE Delfel Road over the weekend from Friday, November 30<sup>th</sup> thru Monday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> and find out!!! Events begin a 9:00 AM and run through 3:00 PM each day.

During that weekend, The Greater Clark County Kennel Club in conjunction with Royal Canin USA and the American Kennel Club will sponsor the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Super Dog Competition during its Performance Games Weekend.

Here's how it works. We will be staging 13 different events in which ANY dog can participate. Here's the list:

Agility

Barn Hunt

Carting

Dock Diving

Fast CAT

Flyball

Obedience

Rally

Scent Work

Trick Dog

Up Dog (Frisbee)

CGC (Canine Good Citizen)

Farm Dog CGC (Good Citizen with a Farming Twist)

Any dog many enter any or all of these events. When you come to the Event Center, look for the table with the Super Dog display and pick up one of the Super Dog scoresheets available to everyone. Each event you enter garners you 1 point for entering and additional points based on how well your dog does in each event. Some events are scored and some are pass/fail. When you've completed any event, the steward for that event will stamp your score card and indicate the total score you received during that event.

Here's an example. In Fast CAT, a dog is held by its owner as an empty white garbage bag (the rabbit) is hooked to a pulley system. When the bag shoots by the dog, the handler lets it go and we gauge the overall involvement of the dog. If he chases the bag, he will tally 1 point for entering and 2 points for "passing" the test. If he's not interested in the chase (and some dogs just aren't), he will get 1 point for entering.

Each event is scored in the same manner although some get points based on how well they performed rather than just a pass/no pass award.

When you've completed all of the events you wanted to enter EACH DAY, bring your form back to the official table and all results will be tallied at the end of the day. The dogs with the 4 highest point total will be awarded nice prizes provided by Royal Canin USA.

The dogs love doing these kinds of sports. If you haven't tried any of these, you'll be amazed at how quickly they figure out what's going on. They have fun and you have fun and that's what it's all about.

So, come down to the Clark County Fairgrounds that weekend and see if, as you suspect, there's a Super Dog living in your home.
