

MINUTES OF THE February 10th, 2021 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BEARDSTOWN COMMUNITY PARK DISTRICT, CASS COUNTY, ILLINOIS, HELD AT 6:30 pm ON February 10th, 2021 AT THE SCHEWE COMMUNITY CENTER, 6 ARMORY LANE, BEARDSTOWN, ILLINOIS.

The February 10th meeting of the Beardstown Park District board of commissioners was held on February 10, 2021 at the Schewe Community Center. President Nathan Carls called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm and roll was taken. Commissioners present included Nathan Carls, Becky Jones, Travis Schroll, Joe McClenning and Josh Sorrells. Also in attendance was Park Director Jason Brockschmidt.

The minutes of the January 13th regular meeting and the January 20th special meeting were approved on a motion by Mrs. Jones and a second by Mr. Sorrells with all board members voting to approve.

The Treasurers report and the Claims List were approved on a motion by Mr. Schroll and a second by Mr. McClenning with all directors voting yea.

Mr. Brockschmidt then presented the Director's Report. He announced that the National Guard was not allowing use of the gym for anything other than walking and only when the Recruiter, Sgt. Miller was present.

Next, Director Brockschmidt informed the board that a 1,2,3 Play program for 2-4 year old's and a Science Explorer's program for 5-12 year old's were set to begin February 16 and February 17 and run through March 24, being held in the meeting room.

Following this Director Brockschmidt informed the board that he had sent out letters to last year's summer staff to see who would be returning to work for the Park this summer.

The board then discussed the hiring of a part time secretary in addition to hiring a full time maintenance person as was approved at the January 20th special meeting. Mr. McClenning made motion that we advertise immediately for a full time Maintenance Director and a part time Secretary. Mr. Sorrells seconded the motion and all board members voted in favor.

Finally, Mr. Carls informed the board that he and his team were awarded the Cyclocross State Championship for 2021 and asked the board for permission to use the park to host the race again on October 2 and 3, 2021. Mr. Schroll moved to allow use of the park by Mr. Carls and his team those 2 days, Mrs. Jones seconded the motion and all directors voted yes.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm with a motion from Mr. Sorrells and a second by Mr. McClenning.
