Did you know that Giles County Public Library is celebrating 80 years this year? This library opened in the original building on this spot in January 1941 from a donation from Cornelius Abernathy and Maggie Sinclair Craig. Make sure to watch for articles in the Pulaski Citizen for stories about the library and its history throughout the year as we continue to celebrate the whole year.

Since Spring is here, and Summer is approaching, we are so happy to report that we are starting to have more in-person programming! We want to introduce Teresa Burns, our new Program Coordinator. Teresa is planning to get us back into business with in-person programming. And we cannot wait!

**Lego Club** is starting back with a limit of 10 for our small meeting room on May 13<sup>th</sup> from 3:30-4:30. Please call ahead and sign up.

**Story Time** is still at 10:15 on Fridays. **Dungeons & Dragons** for Teens will continue meeting at 2:30 on Fridays in May, but will move to Mondays at 2:30 during June and July for Summer Reading.

**Teen Creative Club** will restart on Thursday, June 3 from 3:30-5:00, and **Fandom Free Play** will return on Thursday, June 17 from 3:30-5:00. Look for Creative Club on the first Thursdays from 3:30-5:00 and Fandom Free Play on the third Thursdays, same time.

Our **Code Clubs** are still meeting virtually through the end of May on Mondays. Spring is also the time of the year that the library plans for all the activities for **Summer Reading**. This year's Summer Reading theme is **Tails and Tales** and it is for all ages. We are kicking off Summer Reading with an adult program with Carman Brown. Carman was the Citizen Spotlight in the April 7<sup>th</sup> edition of the Pulaski Citizen talking about his Facebook postings of Carman Brown News (CBN) and "history mini nuggets". We thought he would be the perfect person for a program of **Tales of Pulaski**. This program will be held on Thursday, May 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 pm in the First National Bank Theater room. Come join us for a great evening of tales and pictures with Carman Brown.

The official start to Summer Reading is June 7<sup>th</sup> and will run for six weeks through July 16<sup>th</sup>. You can start logging your reading on ReadSquared earning points and badges on June 7<sup>th</sup>. Our longtime sponsor, **First National Bank**, gives us the opportunity to have special programs planned each week which include some of our old favorites such as Bob Tartar's

Animalogy, Mr. Bond and the Science Guys, and the Pleasant Run Creek Walk with TWRA Officer David Crane. You can still access our Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC) from our website [gilescountylibrary.org](http://gilescountylibrary.org) to search our catalog, renew materials or put items on reserve. The new software also has an APP called **Librista** that you can download to your phone or tablet to also manage your library account. I really like the fact that if you are searching our physical catalog in either the OPAC or the APP, you can go straight to Overdrive (READS) to search for E-books or audiobooks and you can sign in from there! There are features you can access on different devices. Check it out! No pun intended.






**Amanda Kidd**

Amanda Kidd did her growing up in Giles County before moving off to the big city of Nashville. After getting her first failing grade on a literature test in Mrs. White's English class at Richland High School, she never hoped to have anything to do with English literature again. The siren song of books never stopped calling, though.

A reader all her life, Amanda finally decided to try her hand at writing. She published a blog titled "Love, Jimmie" and wrote faithfully for eight years. The blog world fell apart, as did her dedication to it, and the only writing she did was for personal consumption or for her annual Christmas letter sent to friends and family. Those letters have some notoriety now as they detail her experiences with trying on Spanx for the first time or her deep-felt emotions about being middle aged.

During 2020 Amanda and her neighbor, Jamie McKean Hodges, began writing a series of essays for each other. These essays were meant to honor the Lord in their own lives but eventually turned into a missive they wanted to share with the world. Or at least their friends and family. "Prayers from the Front Porch" is that missive.




