Survival Tip: Make sure you sign your child in and out when they are late or have to leave early! In the month that holds both Valentine's Day and Family Day, it is especially appropriate to stop and consider the true nature of love. Far too often in our culture, we equate love with a feeling, which unsurprisingly leads people to fall in and out of love. But love was never meant to be a name that we give to feelings of affection, whether romantic or familial. Love is a choice. When Paul writes in his first letter to the Corinthian church that "love is patient, love is kind," he is not describing how feelings of affection might cause us to behave (1 Cor. 13:4-8). Nor is he breaking love down into component parts. Rather, he is simply stating that when we are patient with someone (especially when it's difficult), we are showing them love. When we are kind (again, especially when it's difficult), we are showing them love. When we withhold our prideful boasts to build someone else up, we are showing them love. When we choose to trust someone (even when it's difficult), we are showing them love. When we persevere with someone through difficult circumstances, we are showing them love. Love is a choice. Love is an action. And we, as Christians, are called to love everyone, even when it's difficult. Especially when it's difficult. So show someone today how much you love them.




