Effective October 1, 2016 the following changes will be implemented:

- The church will be opened only on the First and Second Saturdays of each month from 8:30 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.
- The Trustee and Steward Boards meeting will change to the Second Saturday of each month. The meetings will be back to back starting at 8:30 A.M. to 9:45 A.M. and 9:45 A.M. to 11:00 A.M.
- To provide for more professional protection of our members and their vehicles a new security company has been engaged to provide security service on Sundays and for special events as needed. The company is Safegard Protection, LLC.


