GILBERT FIRE AND RESCUE LOCKBOX PROGRAM

We are pleased to introduce the Gilbert Fire and Rescue (GF&R) Lockbox Program to Trilogy residents.

GF&R's Lock Box Program is designed to provide fire personnel (First Responders) access to a home in an emergency situation where the likelihood of forced entry is necessary. Residents, who live alone, are disabled and/or have chronic illness that might require frequent assistance or trips to the Emergency Room, may qualify for a free lockbox. GF&R will place a secure lockbox similar to those used by realtors on an outside spigot with your house key inside. You choose the lockbox code, which is provided to 911 operators who, when you call, will provide the code to the First Responders so they may enter your home to assist you.

Gilbert Fire and Rescue will review applications and assign lockboxes. Lockboxes are installed by GF&R personnel. Residents will need to have an extra house key prepared prior to installation. **This program is free to qualifying residents.** The TPR Foundation provides funding for this program.
