Selma I. Louis, 83, died early Wednesday morning, May 31, 2000, at Tendercare of Cass City following a two-year illness. She was born Nov. 12, 1916, in Brookfield Township, daughter of the late Rudolph and Helen (Beitz) Koch. She was united in marriage to Roland C. Louis on June 5, 1957, in Sebewaing. He preceded her in death on June 19, 1974. Selma had been an elementary school teacher in Bay City for 25 years before retiring several years ago.
