
Trail Rules

- Dogs are allowed, but must remain leashed at all times
- ♦ Do not leave any trash on the trail
- Remain on the trail at all times
- Cleanup after your dog and remove all waste from the trail

Please also note:

- This trail is not a looped trail. It is approximately 3 miles from beginning to end.
- There is no water provided on the trail, please ensure you have water before you begin your hike.
