CODE OF ETHICS FOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Committee members should:

- 1. Strive at all times to serve the best interests of the association as a whole regardless of their personal interests.
- 2. Act within the boundaries of their authority as defined by law and the governing documents of the association.
- 3. Provide opportunities for residents to comment on decisions facing the committee.
- 4. Perform their duties without bias for or against any individual or group of owners or nonowner residents.
- 5. Disclose personal or professional relationship with any company or individual who has or is seeking to have a business relationship with the association.
- 6. Conduct open and fair election of committee chair.

Committee members should not:

- 1. Make unauthorized promises to a contractor, bidder or residents.
- 2. Advocate or support any action or activity that violates a law or regulatory requirement.
- 3. Spend unauthorized associations funds for their own personal use or benefit.
- 4. Misrepresent known facts in any issue involving committee decisions.
- 5. Make personal attacks on colleagues, staff or residents.

7. Spend over \$300 without finance and Board approval.

6. Harass, threaten or attempt through any means to control or instill fear in any board member, committee member, owner, resident, employee or contractor.
