

CHARLES CORMENDY

1916 - 1986

Charles Cormendy, age 69 of Caseville, died Sunday, May 25, at Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe, following a long illness.

He was born Aug. 25, 1916, in Alger, son of the late William and Rosa (Sule) Cormendy. On Aug. 18, 1951, he was united in marriage to Phyllis Scepaniski in Algonac. Mr. Cormendy retired from the General Motors Corporation in the fall of 1980 and the couple moved to Caseville permanently at that time.

Mr. Cormendy was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Caseville; a WW II Army Veteran, having served in Europe and receiving the Bronze Star and Silver Star for bravery; and a member of the Caro VFW Post.

Surviving are his wife, Phyllis; two brothers, William of Cincinnati, and Louis of Reese; two sisters, Mrs. Marion Broese of Livonia, and Mrs. Ann Krison of Ferndale; and several nieces and nephews.

One brother, Joseph, and two sisters, Rose Schutt and Ida Kan, preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. today (Wednesday), at the Caseville Chapel of the Champagne Funeral Chapels. Rev. Ray R. Ohlendorf, pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Linkville, will officiate, with burial in the Caseville Township Cemetery.
