



I have a few items to let everyone know about:

Our Employee of the Month for the month of November goes to Alex Benton.

There will be no Pre-k on December 20-thru January 2- champ camp will be available only if there is high enough enrollment.

Center will be closed on the 25th and the 26th of December and then closed January 1st.

We will be taking Santa Pictures on December 6th. These pictures will be made only for the parents that sign their child up to take them. There is a \$5 sitting fee charge. You must be signed up and pay money by December 1st for your child to have picture made with Santa.

We will be having our Pre-k Christmas concert on December the 12th at 6:30pm here at our center.

Please be on the lookout for any special holiday events or request sheets in your child's classroom. We will be having lots of fun things going on in our rooms and we don't want anyone to miss out.

Also, please remember that we are a nut free center. If you bring in treats for staff member's to enjoy they must be free on any and all nuts. We want to make sure that all our children are safe.

Please inform us if your child will not be here during the holidays. We need to staff according to the number of children that we will be having. There will be signup sheets posted in the rooms. It is a great help to us to have parents fill these in so that we are not over or under staffed during this time. It also allows staff to have extra time off to have time to spend with their families and finishing up the Christmas shopping needs.

Please remember from 7:45-8 am the lanes in the front of the building will be for Pre-K drop off only. Pre-k parents will be able to drive-up and drop off the children to the Pre-K teacher. All other parents will need to park along side of building and walk your children in.

Please do not bring in outside food. If your child has a food allergy we need a note from a Doctor on file. Notes need to be very detailed as well as have an expiration date. You will need to provide an alternate food as close to what we are having as possible. It needs to be already prepared and ready to serve to child.

No medication of any kind will be given to child without a Doctor note and/or a prescription. Notes from doctors need to be detailed with reason for, signs to look for if for teething, amount, how often, and an expiration date. Medication forms are only good for two weeks.

Please try to have your child here as early as possible so that they're not missing any of the day's main activities. Cut off for regular classes is 11 am unless there is a Dr.'s note. Pre-k cut off time is 8 am.

Parents Please remember that we are a smoke free environment this includes our parking lot.

Parents as the temperatures are starting to cool down it is a great time to get out and be active with your children. I hope that you take the time this month to take walks, hikes, or a stroll to enjoy the nice temperatures and the changing colors.
