

**FRANCES C. (WISSNER)  
STAUFFER  
1889 - 1985**

Frances C. (Wissner) Stauffer, 95, of 5116 Hoffman Street, Elkton, passed away Saturday evening, Jan. 19 at Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

She was born June 16, 1889 in Fair Haven Township, daughter of the late Frank and Augusta (Pobanz) Finkbeiner. She lived in Detroit from 1914 to 1944.

She was united in marriage to Otto Wissner on July 16, 1912 in Kilmanagh. He preceded her in death on May 30, 1930.
