Complex Conversations

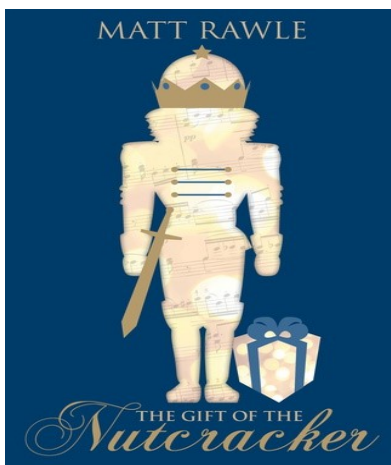
Sunday School Class

Mentors often spend their time in conversation with the child—may play board games, read with them or help with assignments, and sometimes develop other projects with their kid.
