

JL DEMONSTRATION TEAM APPLICATION/AGREEMENT

Read the rules and guidelines before signing up for the demo team. By signing the application, you or your child fully agree and understand the rules. Those under 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the application.

1. Being on the Demo team is neither a right nor a part of your JL monthly fee/contract. This is an added special class by invitation via auditions/tryouts. Student or parent will understand if you or your child is not chosen to perform a routine/skit or pulled from a performance. Not everyone may perform however we will ensure everyone on the team is given equal opportunity given #2 below is met.
2. A student is picked for a skit/routine based on ability to perform and amount of training. Late arrival, missed classes and unexcused absences along with lack of improvements will directly affect Master/Instructor's choices for skits/routines or pulling student(s) from a routine.
3. Student Applicant is over 8 years old and achieves the rank of purple belt and above.
4. Student will not wear jewelry of any kind, belt to be properly tied, clean uniform and be well groomed and not have a sloppy appearance. (Not sloppy = "if getting your picture taken").
5. I understand that practice/training will be very disciplined, strict, repetitious, and physically/mentally challenging.
6. If my child/I join the Demo Team, we suggest you/he/she will prioritize the JL Demo Team over other scheduled activities that may conflict with Demo Team practices and performances. This team is a top priority to Masters, Instructors, and senior team members, if classes are missed, you/your child may be dismissed from the team. *See Attendance Policy.
7. Once on the team, the student will agree and comply with the Absence Policy below

Absence Policy:

- Attendance at all practices and demonstrations is required unless your absence is excused in advance.
- Practices are scheduled for Thursday @ 7:10-7:50PM . Schedule is subject to change and additional practices may be scheduled during the week or weekends.
- If unable to attend, you/your child must communicate directly with the Demo Team coaches or the front office at least 48 hours before any practice and at least 7 days before any demonstration.
- A student may be placed on probation (see below) if you have any of the following:
 - Two(2) unexcused absence from practice
 - Five(5) excused absences from practice
 - One(1) unexcused absence from a demonstration.
 - Three(3) excused absence from a demonstration.
