- Should build community, be accessible to all and meet the needs of the neighborhood
- Raise funds to meet the cost to achieve this: \$750,000

Shields Park

- Eliot Street
- has one infant swing, one fully supportive swing, two belt swings; one 2-12 structure; sandbox
- mulch surfacing
- adjacent gravel lot and ball fields



Mary C Lane • Randolph Ave

- proximity to gravel parking & partially paved path, ball fields
- 5-12 structure, swings
- tire swing
- mulch surfacing



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Kelly Field

- Brook Road, near Pierce middle school
- 5-12 structure, sandbox, 4 swings
- no parking or fully paved paths
- mulch surfacing



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Andrews Park

- Belcher Circle in E. Milton
- 5-12 structure, sandbox, 4 swings, 2-5 ground-level play features
- adjacent to paved parking and fully paved path
- fully fenced in
- mulch surfacing



Shields Park Equipment: \$94,685 / Surfacing: \$61,220

- 2-5 and 5-12 structure
- Climbing Structure
- Infant swings, belt swings, tire swing, seesaw



Mary C Lane Equipment: \$59,472 / Surfacing: \$77,600

- 2-12 structure
- divided by multi-age ground- level collaborative play pieces
- infant swings near more challenging structure to allow for range of ages to play safely near each other



Kelly Field Equipment: \$29,443 / Surfacing: \$30,500

- range of challenging ground- level structures to allow for very young children to play safely alongside older children
- existing swings will remain until flooding issue is resolved





Andrews Park

Equipment: \$169,842 / Surfacing: \$97,315

- Fully accessible for a range of abilities
- structures for ages 2-12
- multiple parallel-play pieces for children of different ages & abilities




